Nippers Nutrition

We have been trying different food this week at snack time We have had fish paté and boiled eggs. The children also made pizza in cooking.

Make your own Fish Paté at home with your child using our recipe:

Ingredients

- 1 can sardines or mackerel in oil (or tomato sauce)
- 100g/4oz full fat soft cheese
- Juice of 1 lemon
- Pepper

Method

1. Remove the skin from smoked mackerel or sardine and drain in a sieve
2. Place the fish and soft cheese in a bowl and mash together toughly with a fork
3. Cut the lemon in half squeeze out the juice, add to the fish mixture and season with pepper.

Chill until ready to serve - perfect with bread sticks or cucumber!

2. Freedom to become an academy





Here at Camborne Nursery School we are a Makaton friendly organisation.

Makaton is a language programme that supports communication using speech and non verbal signs and symbols.

Makaton signs make what we are saying visual, giving an extra 'clue' when trying to process and understand the meaning of a spoken language .

The signs in Makaton are the same across the entire UK.

Makaton supports memory and understanding of language by providing additional visual effect. Using Makaton slows down speech which enables people more time to process the language.
