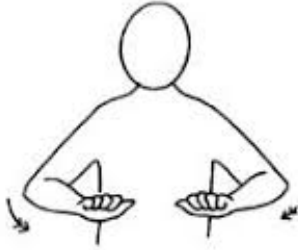
Last week the children enjoyed watching the chicks hatch!
