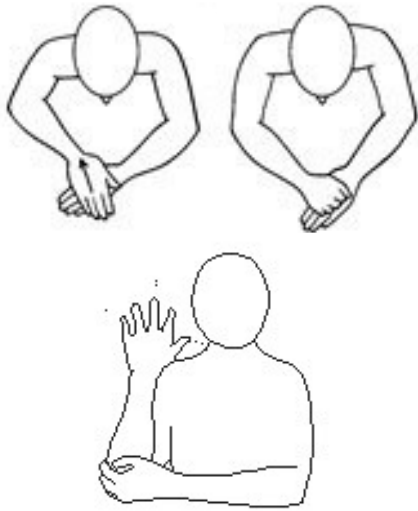

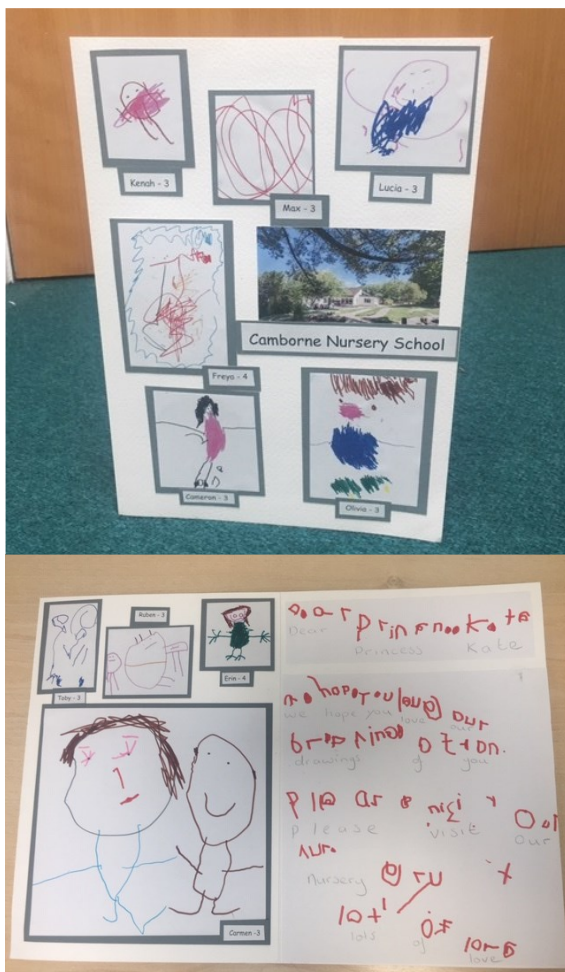
The sign that the children have been learning is:
