Please ensure your child stays away from nursery for **48 hours** following any sickness or diarrhoea. Please consult a doctor or pharmacist for conjunctivitis. Keep your children hydrated with lots of fluids and **teach them how to wash their hands correctly**.



Scrub your hands with soap for at least 20 seconds (sing the happy birthday song twice!) rinse well and make sure they are completely dry.
