THANK YOU TESCO!

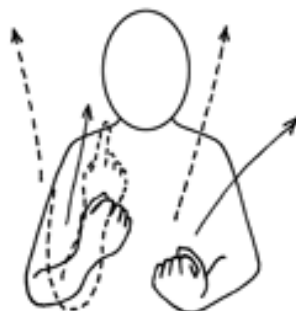
We have been donated buckets and spades by Tesco. We will be giving them to every child to take home. If you take any photos of your child using them we would love to see.

COVID GUIDANCE

What to do if.....	Action Needed	Return to nursery when...
My child has Covid symptoms	• <u>Do not come to nursery</u> • Isolate the whole household • Get a test • Let us know	The test comes back negative. If unable to get a test child must isolate for 10 days since the symptoms started, and the household must isolate for 14 days.
My Child tests positive for Covid	• <u>Do not come to nursery</u> • Isolate the whole household • Let us know ASAP	After 10 days since the symptoms started <u>and</u> when your child feels well again. (Household must isolate for 14 days)
My child's test comes back negative	• Let us know	You have received a negative result
Someone in the household has Covid symptoms	• <u>Do not come to nursery</u> • Isolate the whole household • Household member to get a test • Let us know	The test comes back negative. If household member is unable to get a test the child must isolate for 14 days.
Someone in the household tests positive for Covid	• <u>Do not come to nursery</u> • Isolate whole household • Let us know ASAP	After the child has been in isolation for 14 days.
My child's bubble at nursery is closed due to a positive case	• Child must isolate at home for 14 days • Other siblings can still attend school as long as your child has no symptoms	We will let you know when you can return to nursery.
My child's sibling attending another school is isolating because their school had a positive case	• Sibling must isolate for 14 days	Child can still attend Nursery as long as sibling has no symptoms.

Do you have a child born **between 1 September 2016 and 31 August 2017?**

If so, you will need to apply for a place in a reception class in September 2021 for that child by the deadline of **15 January 2021**.

Please note: you will need to apply even if your child attends a school's nursery or pre-school class. If a school is oversubscribed the fact that a child attends a school's nursery or pre-school, or a local nursery or pre-school, does not automatically guarantee a place at that school. The school's oversubscription criteria will be used to allocate places. Visit our website or contact us for more information.
