We have been hearing of a few families, including young children, testing positive for Covid 19. Luckily everyone has recovered but it has proved to be a very serious illness for many of them.

We are obliged to inform the local authority of any positive cases, so please let us know if you or your child have tested positive. This helps the local Public Health Team build up a picture of cases in Cornwall.

If you or your child have any symptoms please phone 119 to arrange a test or get a free test online. Whilst waiting for results please isolate your whole household. The government advice says you need to get the test done in the first 8 days of having symptoms.

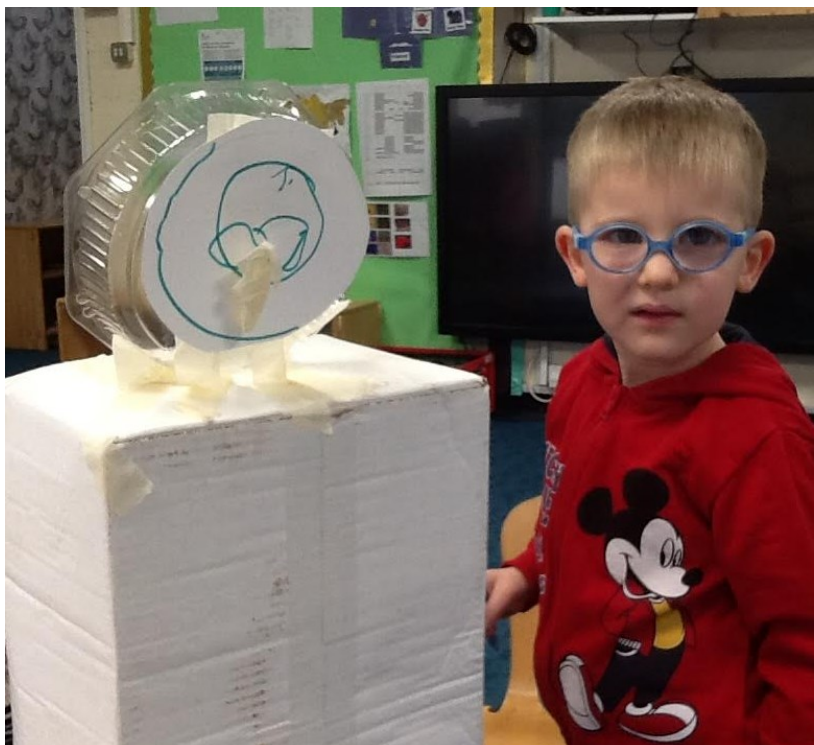






The children in nursery have had another busy week, and really enjoyed seeing all of their friends at home during the online sessions.
