LAST DAY OF TERM



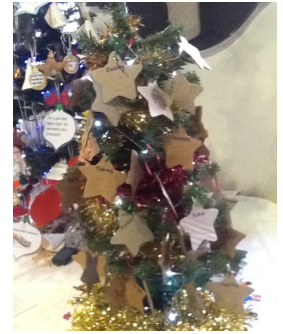
The last day of term is Friday 17th December. **We will be closing early at 1.00pm on this day.**

PACKED LUNCHES

Can you please ensure you are providing your child with a healthy packed lunch.

Here are some suggestion's from our Packed Lunch policy:

- A portion of fruit and one portion of vegetables every day
- A sandwich/ wrap/ pitta bread containing: egg, cheese, meat or fish
- Oily fish, such as salmon at least once every 3 weeks
- Pasta/ rice or crackers
- One portion of dairy foods such as milk, cheese, yoghurt or fromage frais.



Packed lunches **should not** include:

- Confectionary such as chocolate bars and sweets
- Fizzy drinks
- Processed meat products such as sausage rolls should only be included in a packed lunch box occasionally

SICKNESS BUGS

- ♦ Donate bananas, satsumas or small apples

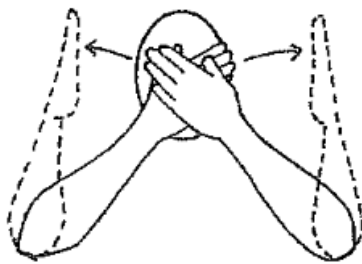

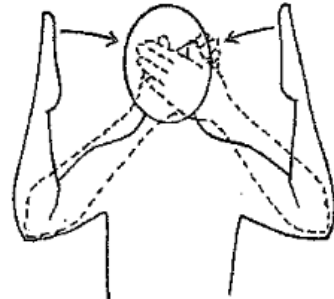
This week the children have been learning the sign for:

DIARY DATES

Friday 19th November - Children in Need

Friday 26th November - Lantern Parade

Do you have a child born **between 1 September 2017 and 31 August 2018?**

If so, you will need to apply for a place in a reception class in September 2022 for that child by the deadline of **15 January 2022**.

Please note: you will need to apply even if your child attends a school's nursery or pre-school class. If a school is oversubscribed the fact that a child attends a school's nursery or pre-school, or a local nursery or pre-school, does not automatically guarantee a place at that school.
