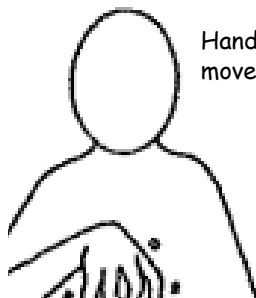

Fish

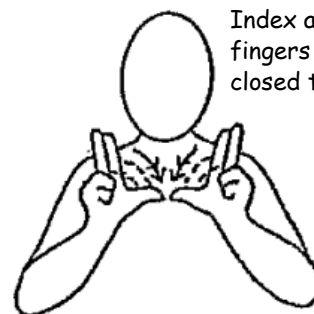


Jellyfish
