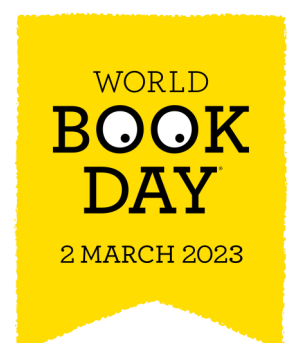

- ♦ Thursday at 9.15am to 10.30am.

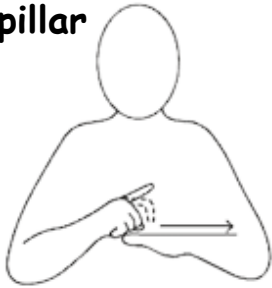

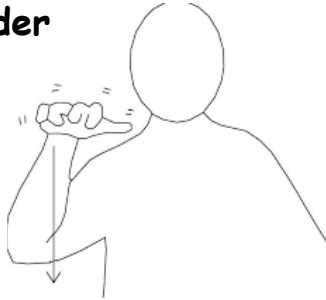

Rhyme time every Wednesday at 10.30am—11.00am

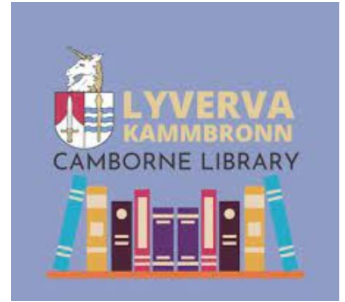
Storytime every Saturday at 10.30am
