POTTY TRAINING

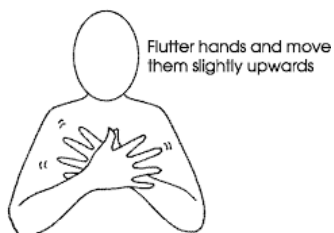
Remember take it slow and never rush your child!
