LANTERN PARADE AND LANTERN MAKING WORKSHOP

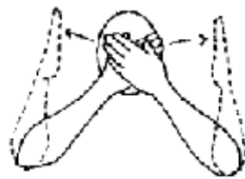

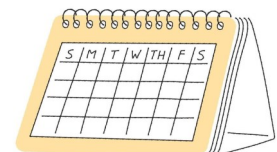
